
## MEET YOUR NEW CONSISTORY


I can't say that I have a favorite Bible verse, so many have meant so much to me it would be hard to pick just one. I think God works that, in that He gives me the verse I need when I need it.

## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

#### PEACH COFFECAKE

- In a large bowl beat together:
- 1 yellow cake mix
- 3 ex-large eggs
- 1 can peach pie filling
