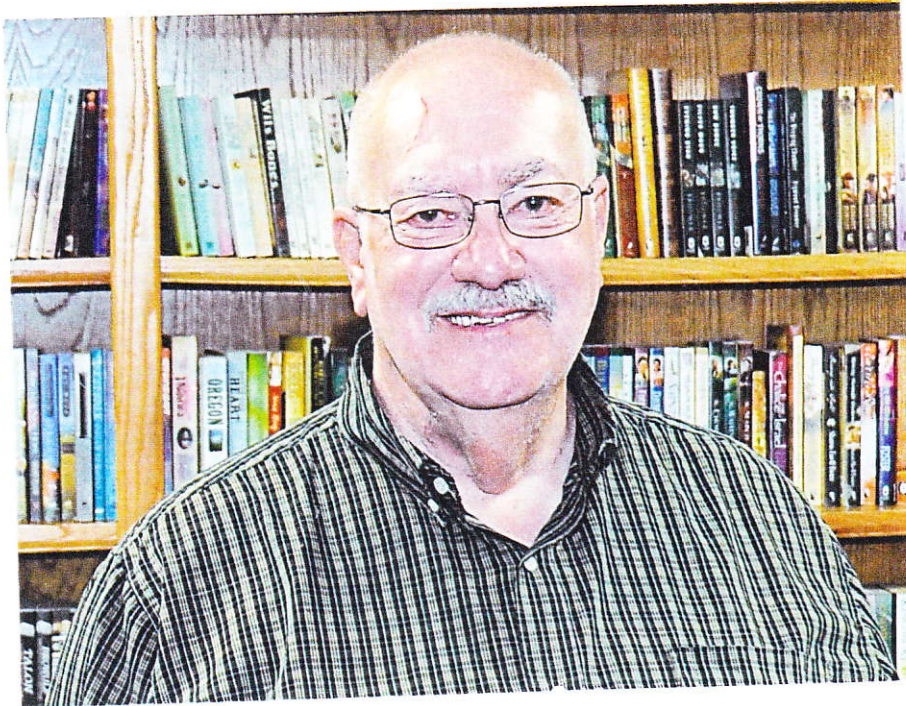


MEET YOUR NEW CONSISTORY

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

PEACH COFFECAKE

In a large bowl beat together:

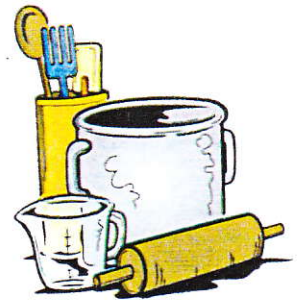
- 1 yellow cake mix
- 3 ex-large eggs
- 1 can peach pie filling
- ½ lemon extract

Grease a 9X13 pan and pour the above mixture in it.

Topping:

- ½ cup flour
- ½ cup sugar
- ¼ cup margarine (Use it cold-right out of the refrigerator.)
- ½ tsp. lemon extract

Mix in a bowl – the mixture will be crumbly. Crumble over the cake. Top the crumb mixture with some sanding sugar. Bake at 350° for about 40 minutes.
